
ELK OF THE MONTH...SHELAGH GOMBARCIK, PER




Lodge Veterans Committee Report





Motivated Mustang Club News

The Motivated Mustangs club met on Tuesday, March 11th at Madison Middle School. This month's club activity was 'Dreams and Goals' oriented. After

chomping on some McDonalds breakfast sandwiches, we got started. Our Tampa Elks Lodge volunteers were Bonnie Atwood, Shelagh Gombarcik PER, Betty Orcutt, Carolyn Miller, Laura Bell, and me.



First, we discussed as a group the definition of motivation.

Then the club members took 10 minutes to write down their 10-year or 20-year dreams. The prompt was "Imagine your life in 10 or 20 years from now. Just for fun, imagine anything is possible. Whatever comes up, just write it down." Then the club members spent another 10 minutes taking one of the dreams for the activity 'Thinking through a long-term dream.' It included writing down potential actions that get you closer, what you will need, why does this goal matter, and key strengths that will help you achieve this goal. Lastly, we spent 10 minutes on accountability. Club members wrote down things they need to stop doing, start doing, and keep on doing to achieve their dream. It was rewarding for the volunteers to help them set eyes on the future and watch their smiles emerge.

In preparation for our club meeting, the Volunteers had homework. They were all asked to come prepared to talk about Who or What motivates them. They came prepared with great responses! My favorite volunteer response was from member Carolyn Miller, who said my mom, Rita Smith PER, was "Someone who motivated her." When we asked the students the same question, they had great responses as well. My favorite responses were from a club member who said that her cousin, who is also in the Motivated Mustang Club, motivates her. I like that they can both benefit from the impact of the club, together.

At every club meeting, we do an attendance award. It is a \$25 Walmart gift card. You get one raffle ticket when you come to the club meeting, if you are wearing your club shirt, you get a second ticket. If you wear your club shirt on any Tuesday that is not a club day AND show Ms Hunziker, the school social worker, you get an additional ticket. 
